RISA Management Corporation Signs Lease at Rotterdam Corporate Park

20 Jobs Coming to Rotterdam as Fast-Growing Metal Fabrication Company Relocates Manufacturing to Schenectady County

Schenectady, N.Y., February 15, 2019 -- Metroplex today announced that RISA Management Corporation based in Maspeth, New York will relocate its manufacturing plant from New Lebanon, NY to the Rotterdam Corporate Park in Schenectady County. The Rotterdam Corporate Park is owned and operated by the Galesi Group. It is the largest business park in the Capital Region. The company has signed a lease to occupy 21,500 square feet of space and will bring 20 new jobs to Schenectady with plans to add 10 additional jobs in the next few years.
